Tryouts: First Week of Fall Semester

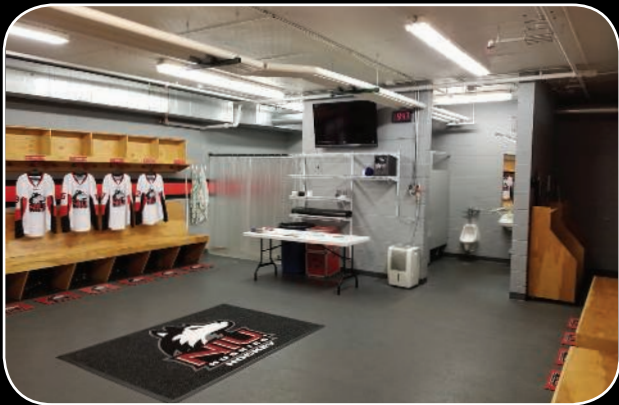
Season Length: August – March
